

CLEANING GREASE TRAPS & PIPING

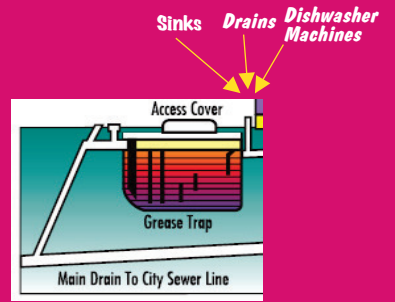


Auto Blaster

Food, Fats, Oils, & Grease, Dirt and other Debris are pushed into the Grease Trap and hard crusts or blockages are formed. This can cause the water to back up and the sinks and dishwashers cannot operate as the water will not drain. F.O.G. Blaster works to break up the blockages and allows the grease trap and drains work properly.

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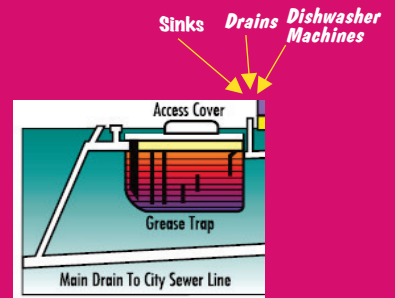


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
